

Before installing Salsa J you have to make sure that you have Java installed





Search in the program files folder. You should have a folder like this one there (called Java). There are two different program files. It is usually in the Program Files (x86)


If you don't have Java take the following steps




Change the extension of the filename .zip into .jar and put it in the plugin directory.



INSTRUCCIONES FOR WINDOWS ONLY

Find the place where Salsa J is installed (Program Files (x86)) and open the folder where Salsa J is.

You should see something like this




Now copy the new SalsaJ.jar that you have unzipped (uncompressed) and replace the one existing in the folder


If you now click in the SalsaJ.jar file (you might not be able to see the extension, it depends on how your computer is set). The icon you should click on is this one

And a bar like this one should appear




Et Voila !!! You have your Salsa J properly working


You will have to delete the Salsa J icon you have in your desktop and create a new shortcut

Click on this file (that is inside the file of Salsa J you have just visited), but use the right button of your mouse. Choose send to desktop (create shortcut)






INSTRUCTIONS FOR WINDOWS ONLY

You should now have a symbol like this in your desktop.



If you want to change the icon to the traditional Salsa J one you just have to click the icon with the right side of the mouse and choose the box to change the icon.

Then click on browse



Find the folder where you have Salsa J (inside program files (x86)) and choose the original icon

Finally click on change icon
